

Tulip Time comes early in 2016: Shawnee County Parks + Recreation to announce start soon

TOPEKA, KAN. – Tulip Time 2016 is coming early! Tulips will also bloom at the Kansas Expocentre and in medians and garden areas in downtown Topeka. There are early, mid and late blooming varieties, so Bartels encourages everyone to visit the gardens more than once to get the full experience of Tulip Time.

Local residents, out of town guests and bus tours make Tulip Time an annual destination. A suggested donation of \$5 per person at Old Prairie Town/Ward-Meade Botanical Garden and Ted Ensley Gardens helps cover the cost of the annual event and enables Tulip Time to continue for future years.
